SECTION I CONSTRUCTION MANAGER RESPONSIBILITY

- g. <u>MPG-Exhibit E (Minor Projects Certificate of Contract Progress & Payments)</u> form is used for partial payments and final payment.

3.2 If the CM

- **c.** Work, which must be performed to eliminate safety violations or remedy emergency conditions.
- **d.** Unforeseen work for which the timing has significant and negative impact on the schedule of the project, or Work for which the university mandates an accelerated schedule to complete component parts of the Project. (Circumstances such as completeness of

safety of the students, university employees, visitors and other contractors day and night.
