While there is ample documentation elsewhere of t



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
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Sharon Williams

- Familiarize yourself with Degree Works Audit
- Make an appointment early in the semester to meet your advisor
- If you plan on discussing how you can improve your grade (+), bring the course syllabus/syllabi
- Bring any questions you have to your advising appointment
- Be on time for your advising appointment
- Inform your advisor of any circumstances that they may assist with
- Ask your advisor for advice on your progress so that you are well informed and understand your degree requirements.
- Show you can enhance your academic profile with internships, volunteering, and student organizations
- Contact your advisor with your questions
- Check Course Catalog for important dates and information
