The process for the Co-Responder Model is as follows: A 911 call is received at MPD. While law enforcement (LE) is responding the call is assessment using an initial questionnaire (unless the location and person is known for mental health and substance use disorder) for the Mobile Crisis Response Team (MRT). Upon determination of MRT need the clinical team is deployed. Once LE secures the scene the MRT begins de-escalating techniques and conducts assessment for need. LE is releaved from scene. MRT connects the person to services, medication management (if necessary), case management services, and 24 hour follow-up to ensure person is stabilized.
