That t is the stance of the Faculty of the University of Buth Horida that no student should be able to earn an undergraduate degre from the University 6 South Florida without having had a sound, basic education concerning the historical and current manifestations and operations of anti-Blackness and systemic accism in American culture and

That t is the stance of its Faculty that, in addition to redoubling its efforts at attracting and retaining talented diversets dents and faculty, the University of South Florida should devote focused attentionand substantial esources of promoting and supporting research aimed to exposing, diagnosing, tracing, and otherwise bringing tight the operations of anti-Blackness and systemic racism, both interior historical and current forms, and from a variety of discipling approaches, and

That it is the stance of the Faculty of the University of South Florida that there should be continual and ongoing rich and comprehensive education for administrators, faculty and staff on issues of systemic racism; and

That it is thestance of its Faculty that the University of South Florida should devote focused attention and substantial resources to research devoted to the development of strategies --political, social, educational, economic, psychologicand other -- for undermining the current operations of anti-Backness and systemic racism and for reversing their iniquitods a devastating effects on individuals and communities.
