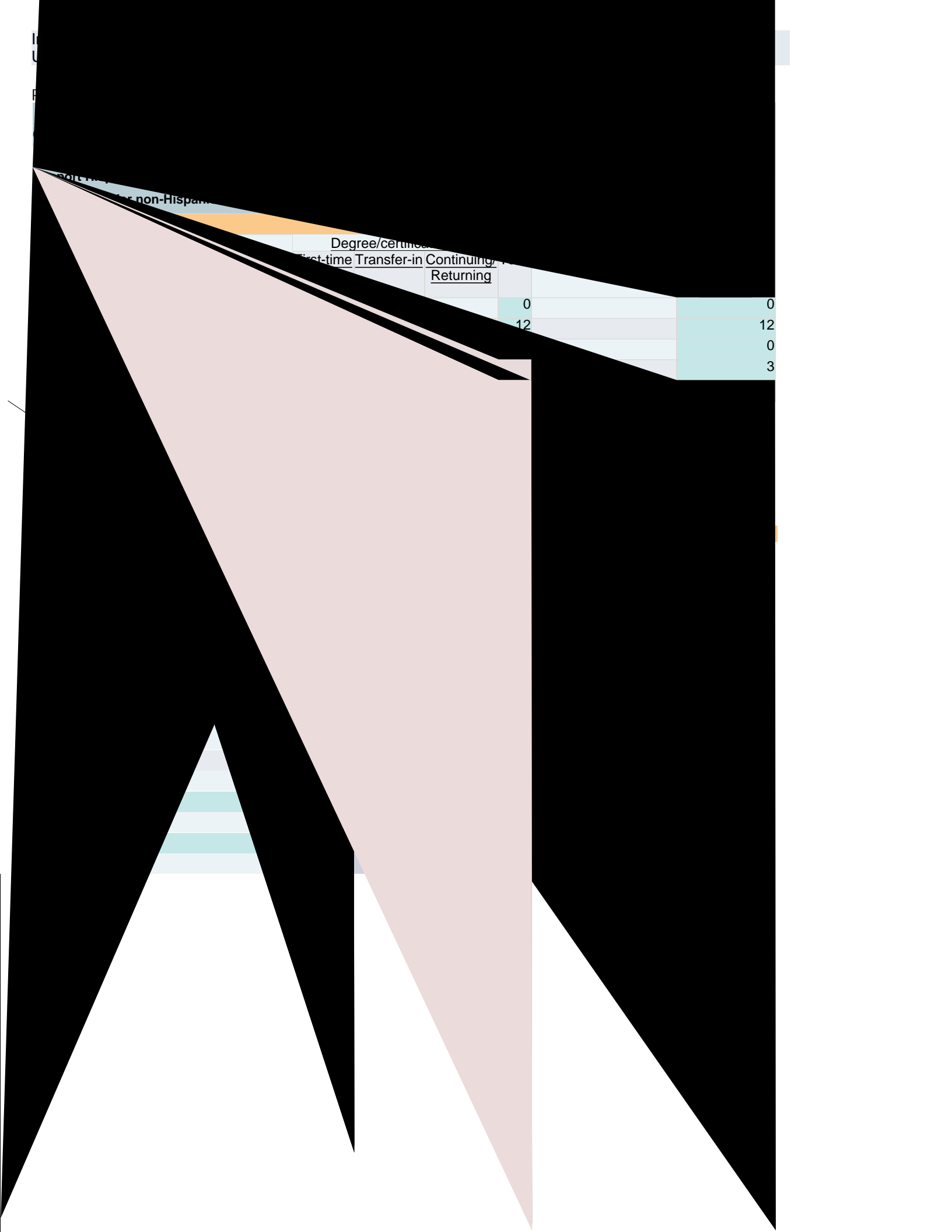

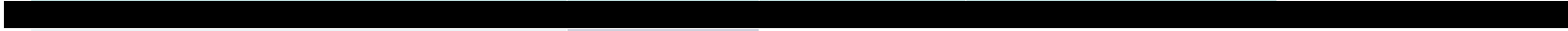











Part E - First-time Bachelor's Cohort Retention Rates (Full-time)
