 - 1. Consent Agenda Discussion and Vote Oscar Bernard Former Undergraduate Council Chair Dr R. Oscar Bernard, with assistance and approval from Chair Dr Uruenagnes, volunteered to draft a formal document clarifying which proposals constitute a consent agenda item and which are more suitable for council review. Examples of proposals that do not require council oversight include those on Course Change Short forms as those are only used to change descriptions, titles, requisites, grading mode, and restrictions. For program changes, nosubstantial changes would include requisite changes, the addition or removal of electives, the addition or removal of core courses that do not impact the overall number of credit hours, and any other changes that help articulate the plans of study.

The Chair may handle additional consent agenda items for proposals that they determine have minimal substantive changes (e.g., addition of a GCP designation), to help reduce the number of reviewers scheduled each week. For
