### Student Accessibility Services Getting the Accommodations You Need When Abroad

#### **Register with Student Accessibility Services (SAS)**

You may already be registered with SAS for academic accommodations. If not, you must register with SAS in order to receive accommodations. You can do this by visiting the [Forms](#) tab on their website and complete an application. You will also be required to supply your disability documentation before your application can be reviewed. Once registered, you will be assigned a coordinator.

#### **Request a SAS Verification Letter be sent to the Education Abroad Advisor**

Schedule a meeting with your SAS coordinator to discuss your plans of studying abroad, and request a SAS Verification Letter to be sent to the EAO regarding your unique circumstances and the accommodations you may need.
